Rifle Specification/Classes: Note: ALL rifles, of any spec, must have an operating magazine (internal or external).

Spec 1: Service - Standard Iron - Any issued iron sights service rifle in original condition-zero modifications.

Sub-Spec 1a: Commonwealth Issue Service - Sub Spec of 1.

Spec 2: Service/Sporter - Modified Service or Sporter non-adjustable rifles with Iron sights.

Spec 3: Open - Match Iron - Any commercial, sporter, factory, service or custom, any calibre, iron sights.

Spec 5: Open - Optical sights - As per any above Spec's but fitted with optical sights.

Sub-Spec 5a: Hunter/Sporter: - Optical sights - limited to factory lite rifles, max 9x scope.

2008 GRAND TOUR Series (GT) Best 3 rounds...

The Grand Tour series is based on the aggregate of your best 3 high power rifle service match results from any of the Grand Tour rounds sanctioned by AIHPA. Using best 3 scores from any of the events means you can shoot as many of the events possible, and only your best 3 count (the more events, the more results to pick the best from). This series runs for all rifle specs, and you may participate in the GT for more than 1 spec.
