If you own a field rifle, factory sporter, 303, Mauser or any type of centrefire rifle, this is **your** weekend! Equip: Either scope or binoculars etc, Shooting Mat, Pen, Eye and Ear protection, licence, etc.

FRIDAY 7.30am ARRIVAL AND SIGN-ON.

MATCH 1 - INTERNATIONAL MATCH COURSE – 88 rounds. (for first rifle spec)

3 Warm Up Shots in 3 minutes.

String 1 200, Deliberate - 2 sighters and 20 shots, Standing Off Hand, on NRA SR target – 22min. String 2 200, Rapid - 2 sighters then 2x 10 shots 60 seconds, Sitting or Kneeling, SR target.

String 3 300, Rapid - 2 sighters then 2x 10 shots 70 sec, Prone, SR3 target.
String 4 600, Deliberate - 2 sighters and 20 shots, Prone, MR-1 target - 22min

SATURDAY 7.30am ARRIVAL AND SIGN-ON.

MATCH 1a - INTERNATIONAL MATCH COURSE – 88 rounds. (for a different rifle spec) (duplicate IMC80 course)

MATCH 2 - TACTICAL MATCH COURSE – "ANY Rifle" (any sight) (bi-pod or front rest etc only)

- Warm Up, 5 shots in 5 minutes @ 600.
- Entire match shot on SR3 target.
- Deliberate, 10 rounds in 3minutes (no marking), then directly into next string,
- Snap, 5x 6 second exposures to fire 10 rounds.
