FRIDAY RANGE CLOSED - NO ACTIVITY

SATURDAY 7.30am ARRIVAL AND SIGN-ON.

MATCH 1 - INTERNATIONAL MATCH COURSE – 88 rounds.

3 Warm Up Shots in 3 minutes.

String 1	200,	Deliberate	- 2 sighters and 20 shots, Standing Off Hand, on NRA SR target – 22min.
String 2	200,	Rapid	- 2 sighters then 2x 10 shots 60 seconds, Sitting or Kneeling, SR target.
String 3	300,	Rapid	- 2 sighters then 2x 10 shots 70 sec, Prone, SR3 target.
String 4	600,	Deliberate	- 2 sighters and 20 shots, Prone, MR-1 target – 22min

MATCH 2 - TACTICAL MATCH COURSE – “ANY Rifle” (any sight) (bi-pod or front rest etc only)

- Warm Up, 5 shots in 5 minutes @ 600. Entire match shot on MR-1 target.
- Deliberate, 10 rounds in 3minutes (no marking), then directly into next string,
- Snap, 5x 6 second exposures to fire 10 rounds.

SUNDAY 7.30am ARRIVAL AND SIGN-ON.

MATCH 3 - AMC - AUSTRALIAN SERVICE MATCH COURSE – 68 rounds.

300 Slow Fire,	Prone U/S	2 sighters + 10 rounds	12min,	Type B
300 Rapid Fire,	Prone U/S	5+5 rounds	30-30-30sec,	Type B
300 Snap Fire,	Prone U/S	2 sighters +10 rounds	3sec per exp,	Fig 12
200 Rapid Fire,	Sitting U/S	2 sighters + 5+5 rounds	30-30-30sec,	Fig 11
200 Snap Fire,	Sitting U/S	2 sighters + 10 rounds	3sec per shot,	Fig 12
100 Snap Fire,	Standing U/S	2 sighters + 10 rounds	3sec per shot,	Fig 12

As Issued Service Rifle: e.g. Military rifles in as issued condition only. (spec.1 & 1a)

Match Rifle Iron: e.g. Military & commercial actions, iron sights. (spec.2&3)

Match Rifle Optic: e.g. Military & commercial actions, scoped. (spec.5 & 5a)
