



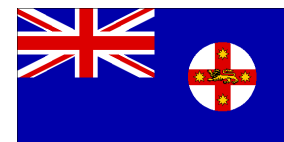

If you own a field rifle, factory, sporter, 303, Mauser or any type of centrefire rifle, this is **your** weekend!
Equip: Either scope or binoculars etc, Grade Card, Shooting Mat, Pen, Eye and Ear protection, licence, etc.

THURSDAY 7.30am ARRIVAL AND SIGN-ON.

MATCH 1 - IMC - INTERNATIONAL SERVICE MATCH COURSE – 88 rounds.

- String 1 200, Deliberate - 2 sighters and 20 shots, Standing Off Hand, on NRA SR target – 22min.
- String 2 200, Rapid - 2 sighters then 2x 10 shots 60 seconds, Sitting or Kneeling, SR target.
- String 3 300, Rapid - 2 sighters then 2x 10 shots 70 sec, Prone, SR3 target.
- String 4 600, Deliberate - 2 sighters and 20 shots, Prone, SR3 target – 22min

MATCH 2 - TACTICAL HARD-CORE

“ANY Rifle” (any sight) (bi-pod or front rest etc only)

- Warm Up, 5 shots in 5 minutes @ 700 – no further sighters.
- 60 rounds - Forced Deliberate, Rapid & Snap fire, per course (see full course on website).
- Shot over distances 700, 600, 500, 400, 300 & 200 on Type B, Fig 11, 12 & 14 targets.
- Entire match is shot in one visit to the range starting at 700 and closing-in on targets.

FRIDAY 7.30am ARRIVAL AND SIGN-ON.

MATCH 1b - IMC - INTERNATIONAL SERVICE MATCH COURSE (2nd rifle spec choice)

MATCH 3 - TMC - TACTICAL – “ANY Rifle” (any sight) (bi-pod or front rest etc only)

Warm Up 5 shots in 5 minutes @ 600. Entire match shot on MR-1 target.

- Deliberate, 10 rounds in 3minutes (no marking), then directly into next string,
- Snap, 5x 6-second exposures to fire 10 rounds total.

SATURDAY 7.30am ARRIVAL AND SIGN-ON.

MATCH 4 - AMC AUSTRALIAN SERVICE NSW STATE TITLES

- 300m Slow Fire, Prone U/S 2 sighters + 10 rounds 12min, Fig 12 4x4
- 300m Rapid Fire, Prone U/S 10 rounds 30-30-30sec, Fig 12 4x4
- 300m Snap Fire, Prone U/S 10 rounds 3sec per exp, Fig 12 4x4
- 200m Rapid Fire, Sitting U/S 2 sighters + 10 rounds 30-30-30sec, Fig 11
- 200m Snap Fire, Sitting U/S 2 sighters + 10 rounds 3sec per shot, Fig 12
- 100m Snap Fire, Standing U/S 2 sighters + 10 rounds 3sec per shot, Fig 12

MATCH 5 - VMC - VINTAGE SERVICE NSW STATE TITLES – Spec 1 only, others for fun.

- String 1 200, Slow Fire - 5 sighters and 10 shots, Prone, 15min. Whole match on SR target.
- String 2 200, Rapid - 10 shots, 70 seconds Prone from standing.
- String 3 200, Rapid - 10 shots 70 seconds, Sitting or Kneeling.
- String 4 200, Deliberate - 10 shots, Standing Off Hand, 10min.

SUNDAY 7.30am ARRIVAL AND SIGN-ON.
